

Easy Steps To Mounting Your Panels (DIY Tips)

There are 3 simple ways to mount your panels.

1. Flat panels with mounting holes on perimeter (standard panels sold on our website). Simply requires the panel to be screwed in as standard panels come with mounting holes unless otherwise advised.
2. Panels with bent flanges. These are panels that come with bent flanges on either all 4-sides or horizontal sides or vertical sides. This is considered additional customization with additional costs as well that may be purchased

alongside your regular panel and must correspond with the quantity of panels ordered.

3. Dado method – this requires carpentry skills to cut grooves into your wood to fit the railing in and must be done by a professional contractor or carpenter.

Note: The panels on our website are standard panels that come with mounting holes on the perimeter of the panels. The border is usually 2 inches wide and the mounting holes are an inch in. The number of mounting holes will depend on the size of your panels.
